Priority is given to older students in the selection process, although students who return their forms by the above stated deadline will be in a stronger position to gain a place.

All the activities on offer depend on attracting viable numbers of students, should an activity not attract sufficient numbers, it will be withdrawn.

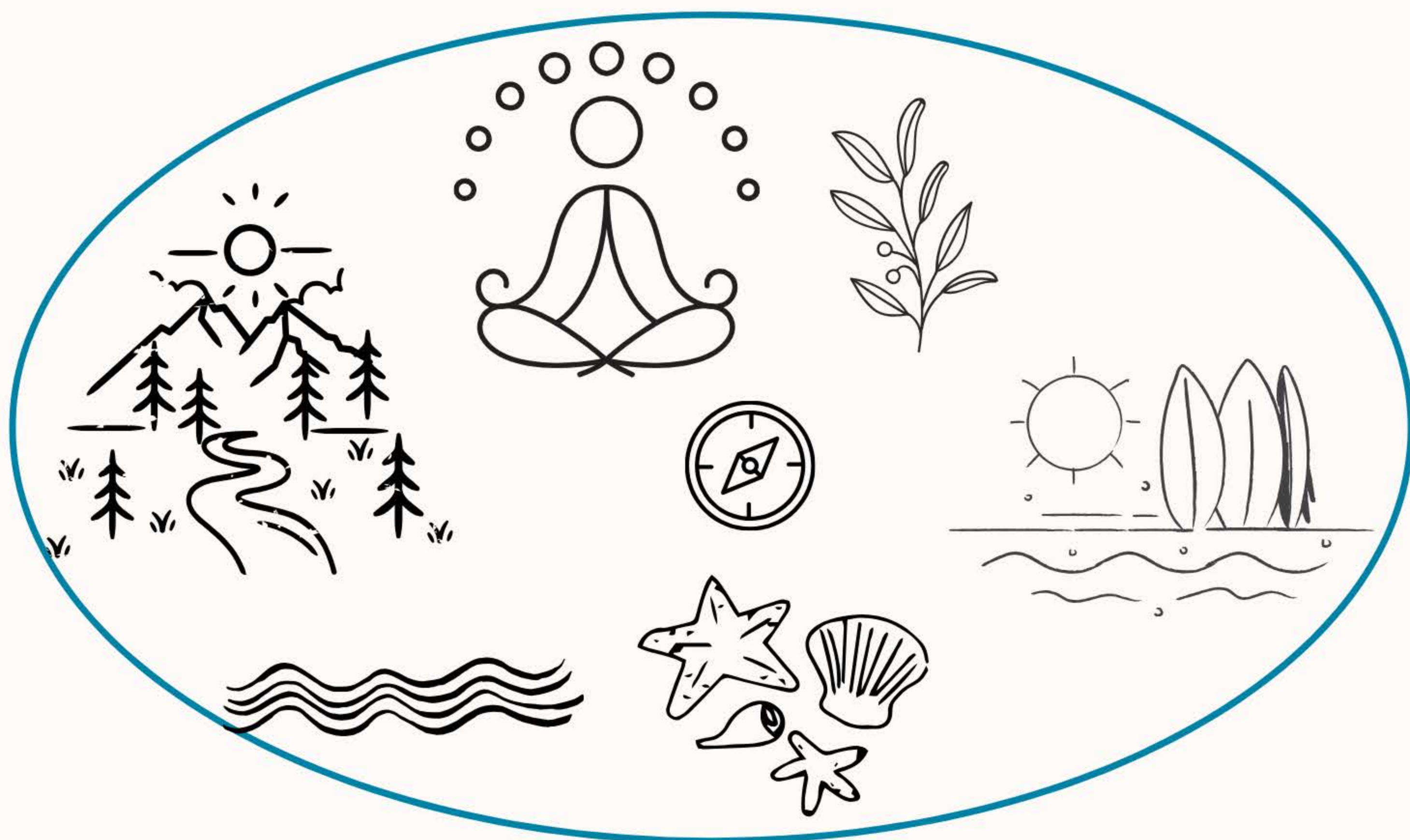

## Fashion Textiles Activity

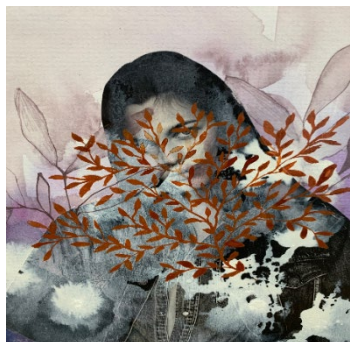
Aspiring to be a fashion or textiles designer? Then this is the activity for you! Spend the week designing and preparing for a small fashion show or fashion photography shoot.
